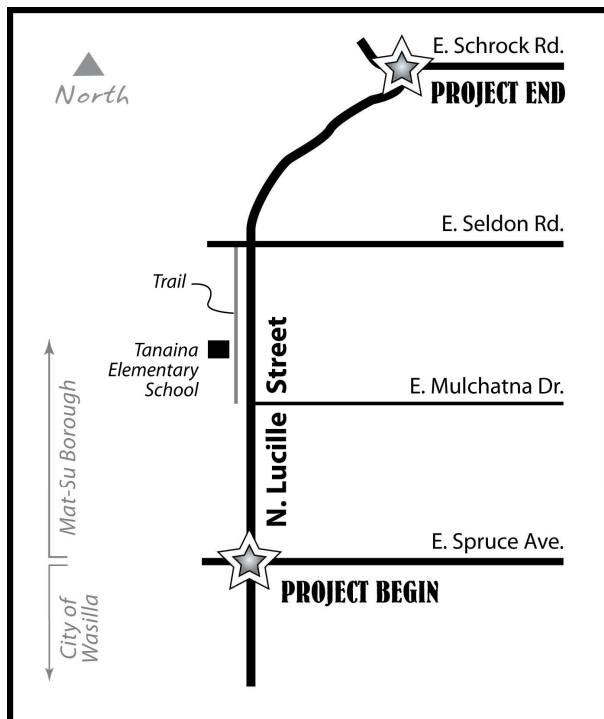
FACT SHEET

The Matanuska-Susitna Borough has received a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development to study the feasibility of improving North Lucille Street between E. Spruce Avenue and E. Schrock Road. The project will consider adding lanes to N. Lucille Street, with safety upgrades to the intersection at N. Lucille and E. Seldon Road. Funding includes pre-design, right-of-way and environmental studies. A final reconnaissance-level report is expected in June, 2009. Final design and construction funding has not been identified at this time.
