

Parks Highway, M.P. 83-90, Weight Restriction Elimination Project

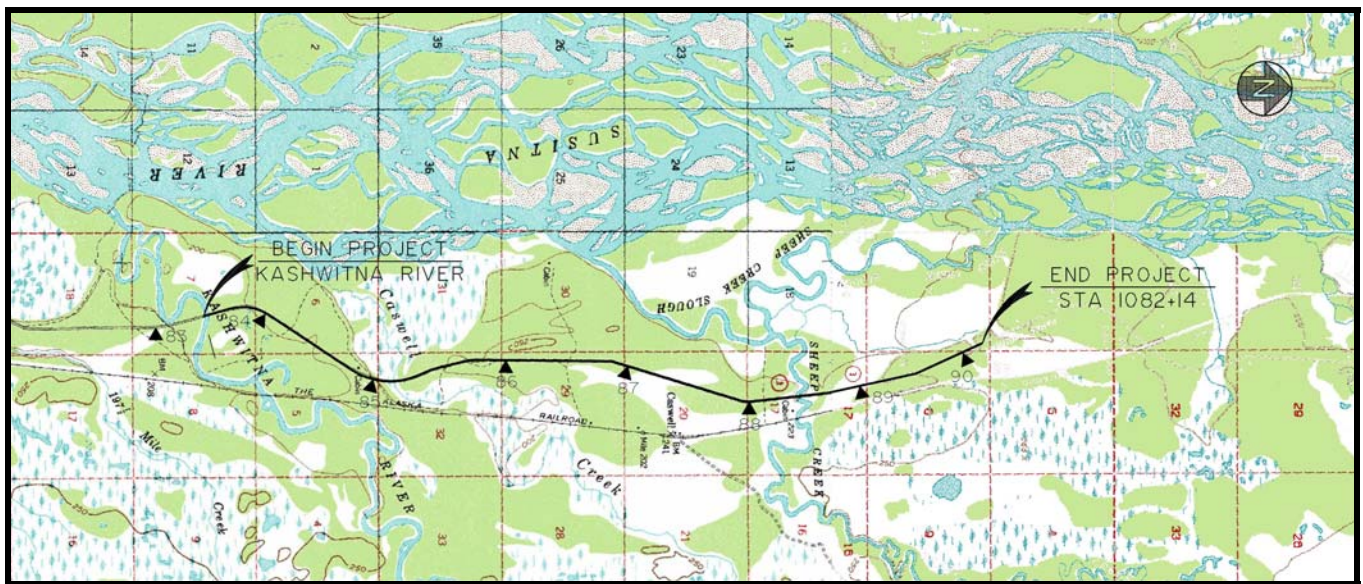

FACT SHEET

This portion of the Parks Highway was identified as a weight restriction elimination priority that needs improvement to remove the current seasonal weight restrictions. This 35-year old highway section needs rehabilitation to correct aging pavement and embankment movement issues. The purpose of this project is to:

- Remove seasonal weight restrictions;
- Rehabilitate the pavement;
- Preserve and extend the embankment service life;
- Provide vehicle slow vehicle turnout improvements.

The project will rehabilitate the existing highway embankment to include removal and replacement of portions of the roadbed. The roadway will resurfaced with new asphalt pavement. The existing pavement will be salvaged for use as base course or placed in the embankment. Slow vehicle turnouts will be added near Susitna Shores Road and MP 89.



Project Schedule

Construction is scheduled to begin in Fall of 2010 and continue through Fall of 2012.
