Blueberry Area Water and Street Improvements

The Blueberry Area Water and Street Improvements project will replace the water system and improve streets in the area northeast of the city-center, between Alaska Street and Denali Street, from Cottonwood Avenue to Arctic Avenue. Design of this project is just beginning. The anticipated components include about 3,600 feet of water main replacement and 4,400 feet of street improvements, including paving, sidewalks, storm drains, and streetlights. The estimated cost is \$4.4 million.

The project will begin construction in 2009. Funding will come from a combination of State, Borough and City funds, along with a special assessment for a portion of the paving cost for those property owners on the affected streets.

The project team would appreciate your to help identify problems related to drainage, special needs, vehicle crash locations, and other issues in the project area. A public meeting will be held the end of October, where you can provide your input and learn more about the project.

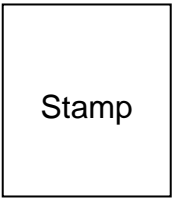
